First YAKSHA End-user Event in Malaysia

The YAKSHA project is organising its First End-user Event in Malaysia on November 27-28, 2019

With the YAKSHA project being close to completing the first two years of project lifetime, the time has come to give visibility to first outcomes of the project work, including information about the YAKSHA technology developed and currently being tested in three pilot sites, to potential end-users and further interested stakeholders. YAKSHA shall provide such information and insights at the occasion of its first End-user Event. More in detail, this two-days event aims to provide the opportunity to learn more about the project, to become familiarised with and test the YAKSHA software, provide feedback, and discuss its future exploitation and market uptake possibilities and requirements. In addition, the event will contribute to the further development of a cybersecurity community and ecosystem in the ASEAN region.

The first day will be a public conference open to end-users, YAKSHA Ambassadors, and other stakeholders interested in learning more about the impact of cybersecurity in Europe and the ASEAN region. The programme includes speeches and panel discussions from key experts in the field of cybersecurity from the ASEAN and Europe, and high-level governmental stakeholders.

The second day will be dedicated to stakeholders and end-users who have become YAKSHA Ambassadors. Ambassadors will be given the opportunity to explore and test first-hand the software developed by the YAKSHA project - which is one of the benefits granted to YAKSHA Ambassadors.

YAKSHA Ambassadors are voluntary representatives of YAKSHA in the ASEAN countries. Active in the field of cybersecurity, software and/or more largely in internet security and defence, and experienced in working with cybersecurity in Europe or ASEAN Member States, YAKSHA Ambassadors also are potential end-users of the YAKSHA outcomes. As of today, the project is still open to new Ambassadors active in the ASEAN region, interested in supporting the project and contributing to its future sustainability.
